




An Introduction to Datitude

You must have a sound knowledge of, and gained experience in:

- Linux systems administration
- AWS or similar cloud services provider
- networks
- databases both administration and SQL.

We'd also like you to have:

- programme scripting using BASH and Python
- Zabbix or other monitoring tools
- automation including Continuous Integration (CI) and Continuous Delivery (CD).

And it'd be a bonus if you've had some exposure to the following:

- containerisation using tools like Docker
- Tableau or similar BI software
- Talend (cloud data integration).

To succeed in our environment, you'll also need to be:

- team orientated with a strong service ethos
- smart, with oodles of enthusiasm for learning on-the-job and a genuine desire to apply your skills to support business priorities
- a brilliant communicator (written and spoken), and not just with techies
- comfortable using your initiative, and have a hands-on, can-do, attitude
- able to manage multiple projects
- flexible and comfortable prioritising and managing escalated support queries, whilst continuing to move internal systems projects forward
- interested in working in a B2B (business to business) environment
- available to work full-time from our offices in Amersham.
